Post this, Ms. Usha Salvi, Hon. Secretary, JRC/YRC Pune, guided the participants on Planning of JRC/YRC Activities (1:00-1:45 p.m.). After the lunch break, the programme resumed with a session on the Importance of First Aid Training and Disaster Management (2:30 – 3:15 p.m.) by Ms. Rupali Todmal, Member, JRC/YRC Pune. This was followed by an inspiring talk on "Youths in Adventure Activities" (3:15 - 4:00 p.m.) by noted mountaineer Mr. **Umesh Zirpe.** The day concluded with a Group Discussion (4:00 - 4:30 p.m.) led by **Dr.** Abaso Shinde, Counselor, Modern College, Ganeshkhind, Pune, where participants actively shared their views and experiences
